## **BLUE TAPE**Checklist



Exterior	Doors and Windows
Driveway and walkways are free of cracks or uneven areas	All doors open, close and latch smoothly
Exterior paint is evenly applied with no overspray or missed spots	Weather stripping is secure and intact
Siding and trim are properly caulked and undamaged	Locks and deadbolts are functional
Gutters and downspouts are installed and directing water away	Windows open, close and lock
Landscaping is completed and irrigation (if present) is operational	Window screens are undamaged and in place
Interior Rooms	Kitchen and Bathrooms
Walls are free of dings, scuffs, or missing paint	Cabinets open and close properly, no loose hinges
Ceilings are smooth with no water stains or uneven patches	Countertops are free of damage or missing caulk
Floors are level and free of gaps, chips or squeaks	Faucets run hot and cold water, no leaks at base
Trim and baseboards are securely attached	Toilets flush and are securely mounted
electrical outlets have cover plates and function properly	Exhaust fans operate and vent outside
Mechanical and Safety	Final Notes:
HVAC system is operational (test heat and AC)	
Water heater is installed and has no visible leaks	
Smoke and CO detectors are installed and working	
electrical panel is labeled and accessible	
Garage is clean and construction supplies are removed
